

Ubuntu 14.04 Installation

It's easy to install Ubuntu 14.04 in a computer from using a Ubuntu DVD(Kalpavriksha) . Here's what you need to do:

Note:

- Minimum 40GB or more space need free space in Hard drive.
- Computer should have minimum 2GB of RAM.

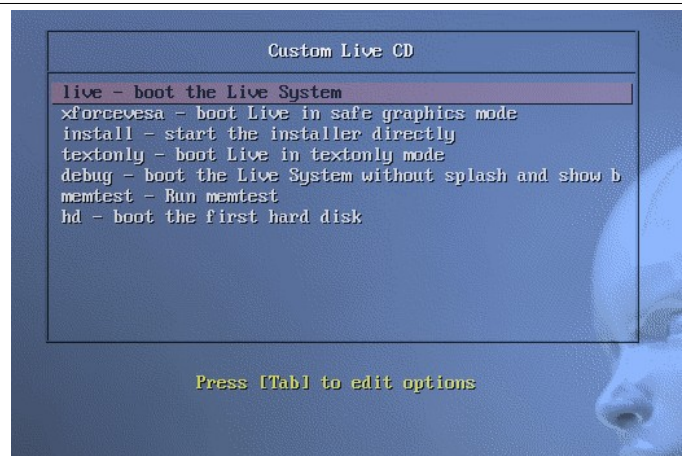
Now , Its time to start Ubuntu installation in your computer

Put the Ubuntu DVD into the DVD-drive

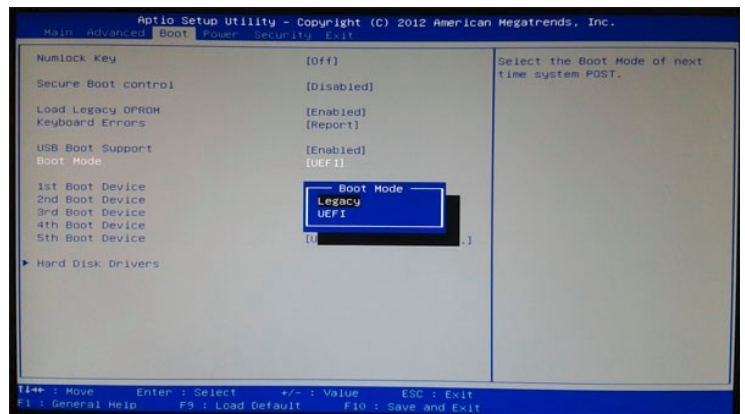
1. **Restart** your computer. You should see a welcome screen as shown in the below screen.

Note: Select Install-Start the installer directly. (In the above screen mouse will not work)

If you don't get this menu,you have to set up BIOS first boot device as DVD drive, for this please follow below steps

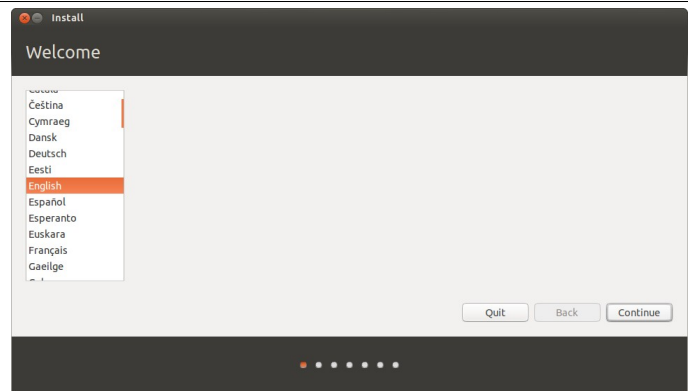


- Restart your computer, computers require you to hold down or press a key to entering a BIOS. The most common way to enter the BIOS is to press the DELETE key(F2,F10,F8 or F12).
- In the above screen you have to select DVD drive as First boot devices then press F10 and save it.
- Now you will see the 1st screen as explained in the first step.



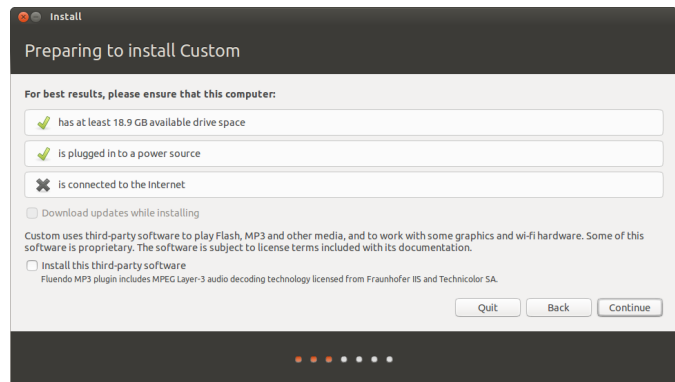
2. Welcome screen :

Click on Continue...



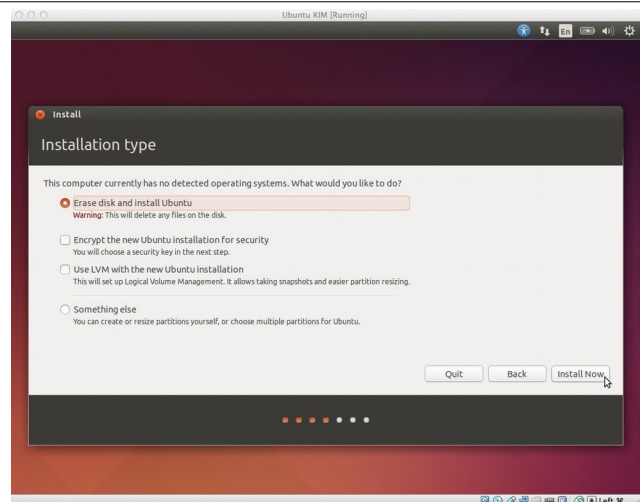
3. Prepare to install Ubuntu :

Click on Continue ..



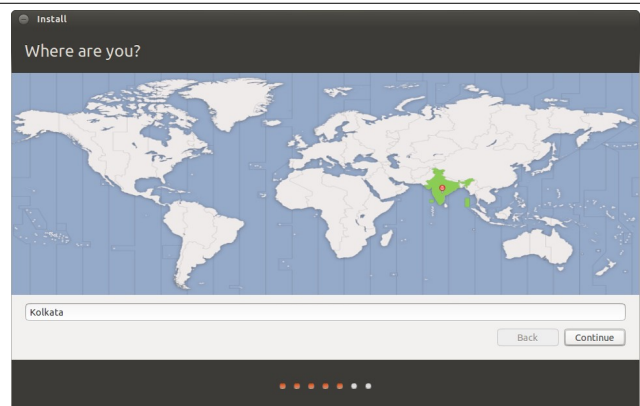
4. In the next screen, you will be asked for the installation options. Select the Installation Ubuntu alongside Windows 7 radio button

Click on Continue...



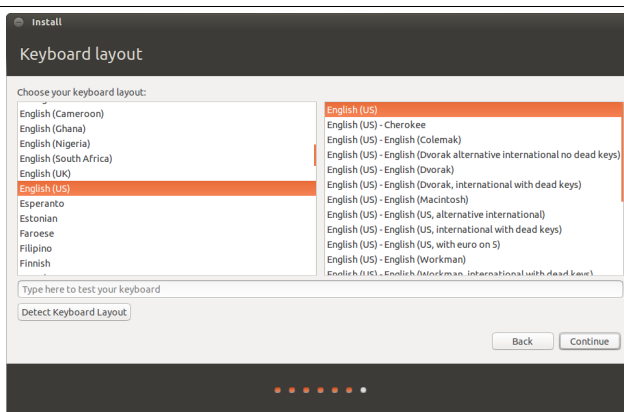
5. Choose Time zone and press Continue

Ubuntu installation along side windows 7/XP

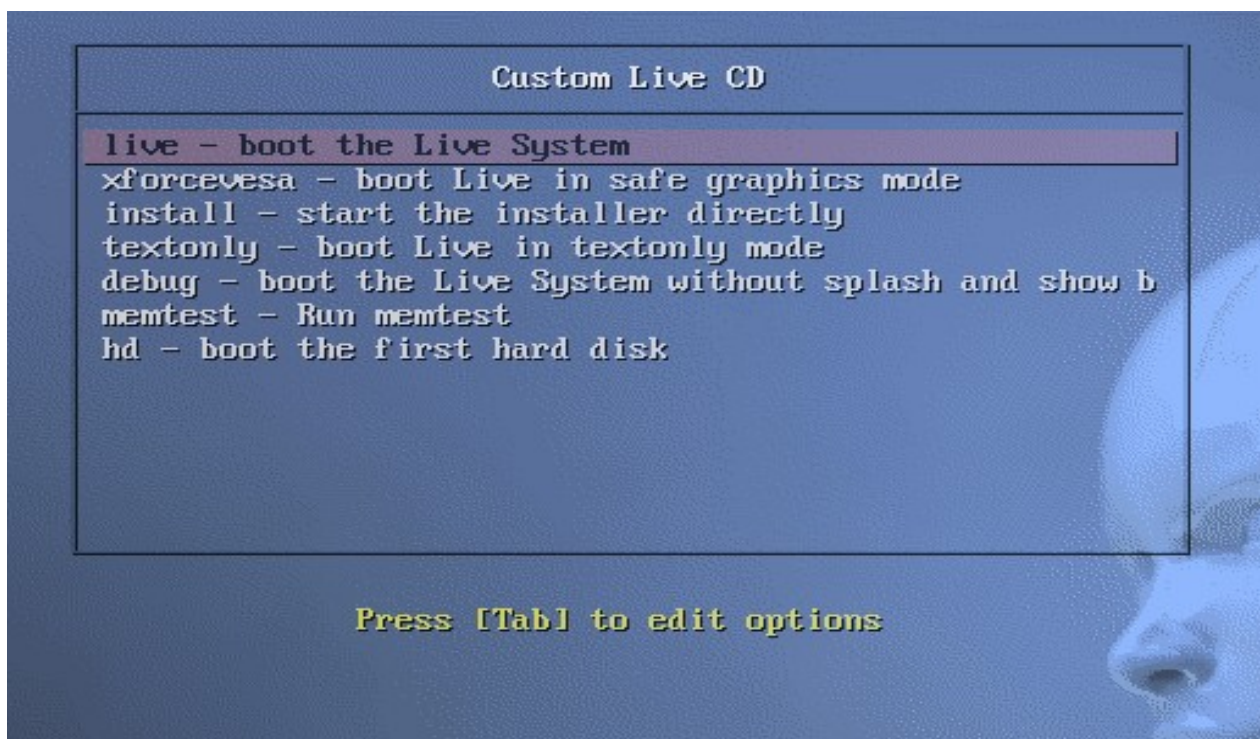
For installing Ubuntu 14.04 along side windows 7 from a Ubuntu DVD(Kalpavriksha) . Here's what you need to do:

1. **Restart** your computer. You should see a welcome screen as shown in the below screen.

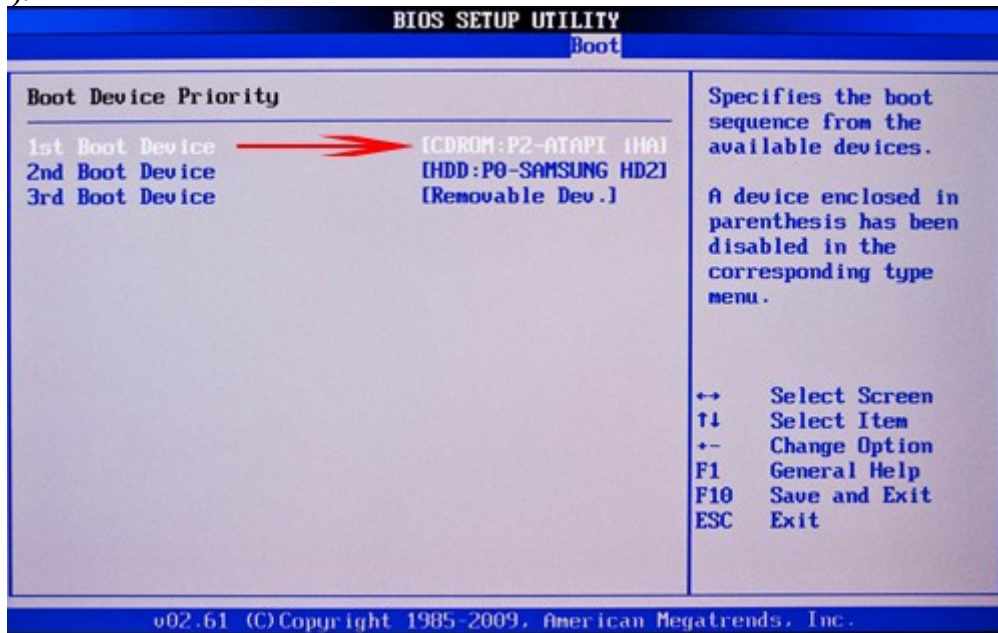

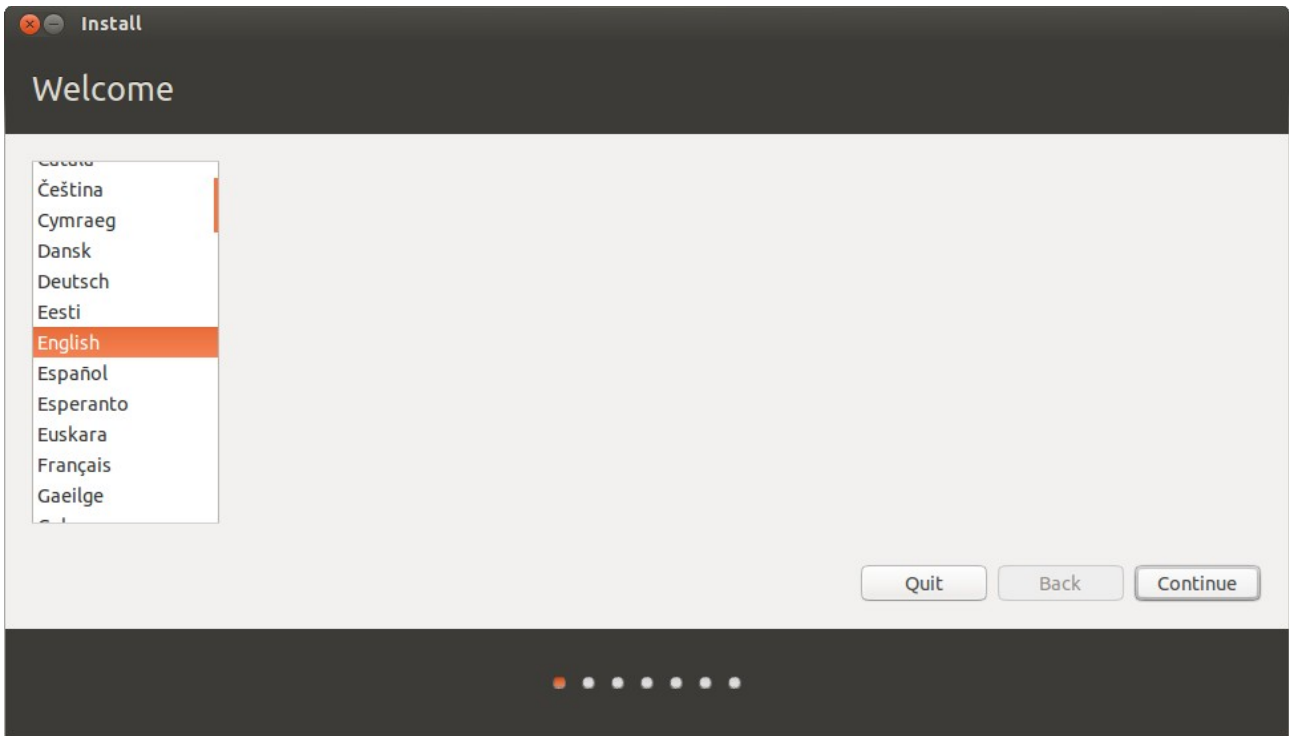


- In the above screen you have to select DVD drive as First boot devices then press F10 and save it.

2. Welcome screen :

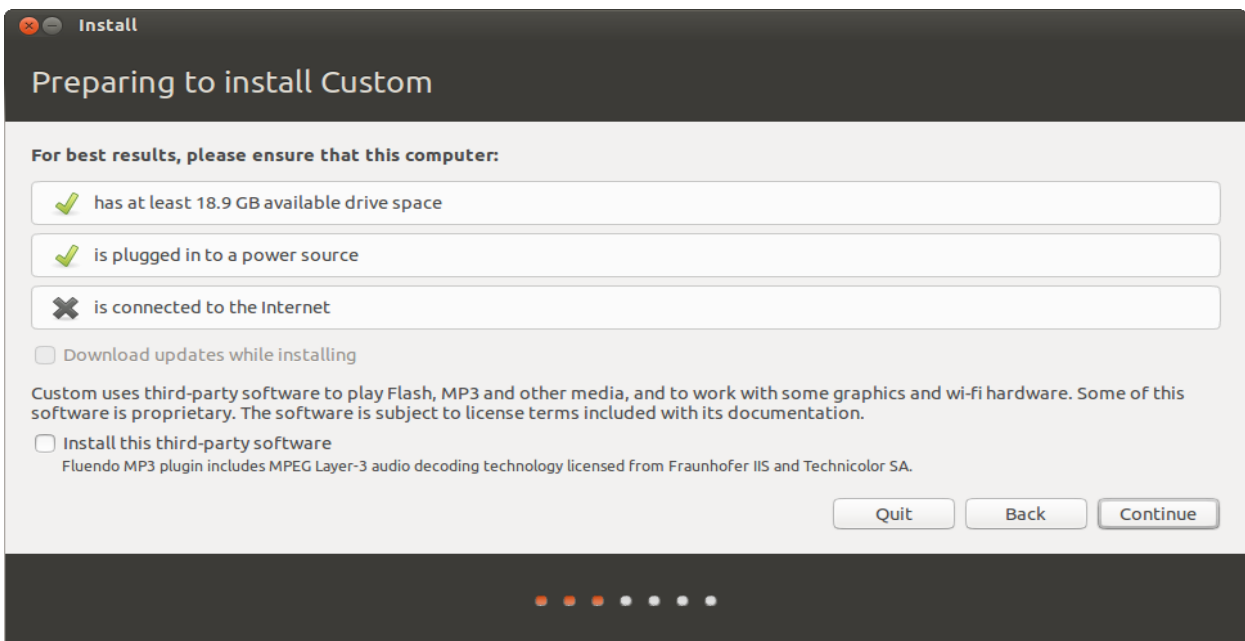
Choose language (English).



Click on Continue...

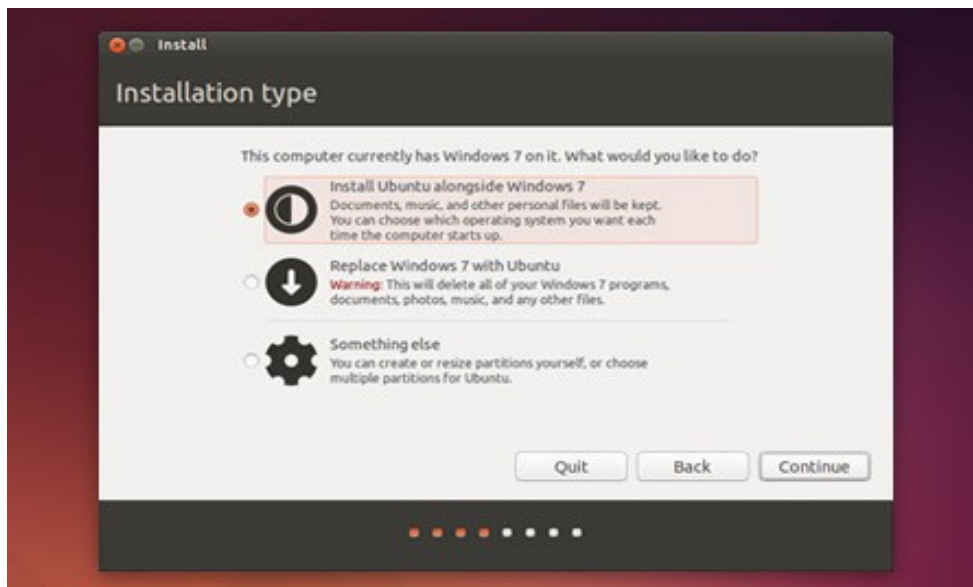
3. Prepare to install Ubuntu :

Click on Continue...

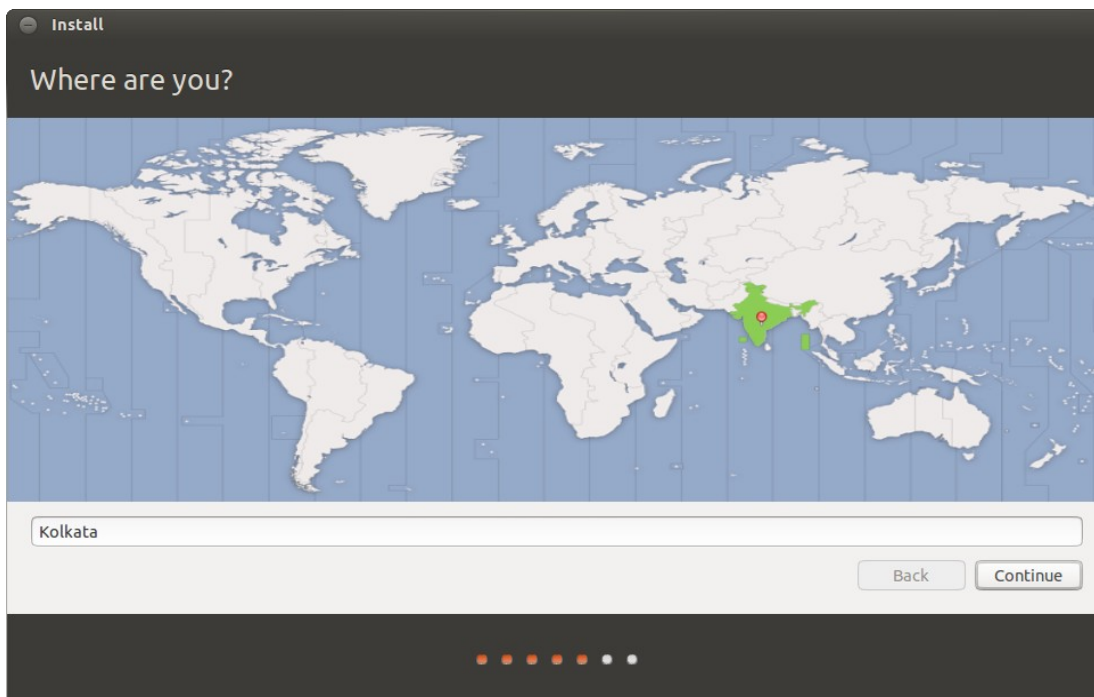
4. In the next screen, you will be asked for the **installation options**. Select the **Installation Ubuntu alongside Windows 7** radio button



Click on Continue...

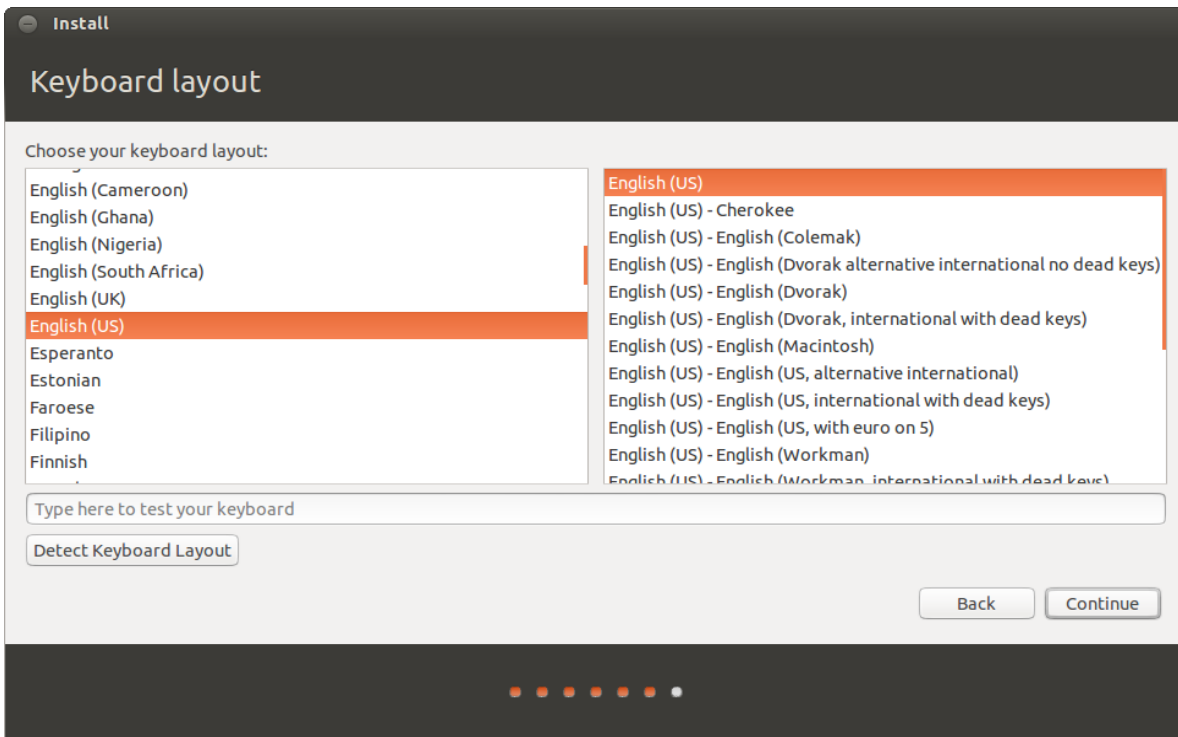
5. It will show the partition size used for Ubuntu. press **Install Now**.

6. Choose Time zone and press **Continue** (In the mean time setup will continue in the background, click on India).



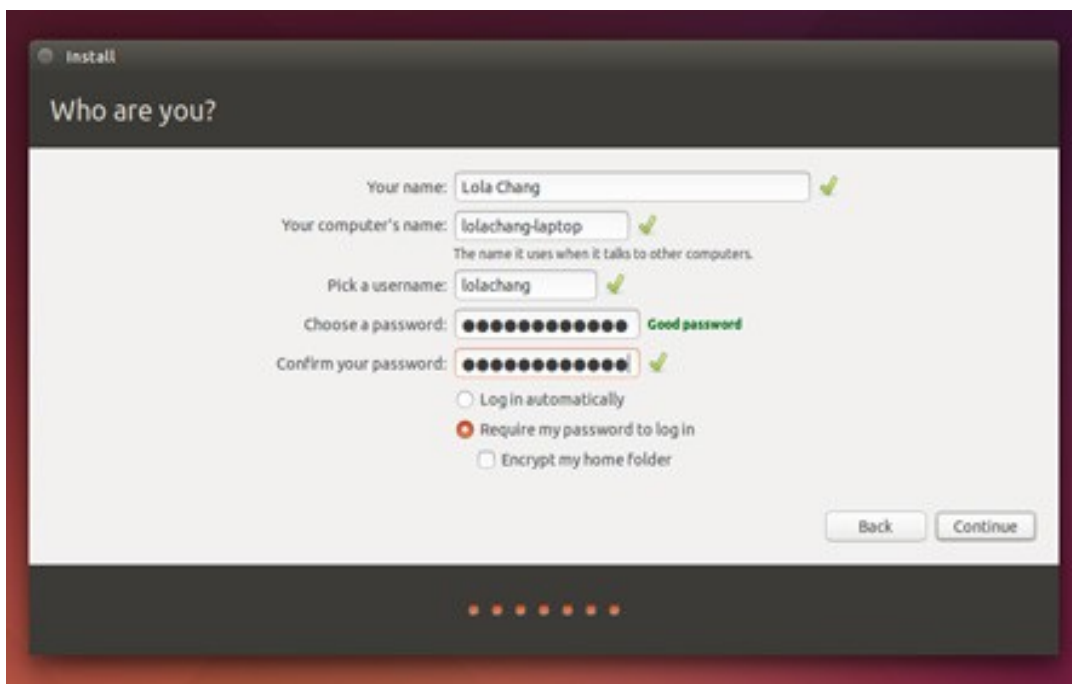
Click on Continue...

7. Now choose keyboard layout , leave as it is and press **Continue**.

8. Type name , computer name , username (for login) and password . But it will take Ubuntu as a password and username as default.



Click on Continue...

9. It will proceed with the rest of the installation.

10. Press **Restart now** and remove installation media(CD/DVD/USB) while rebooting.

Now Installation is completed and you can start use it.
